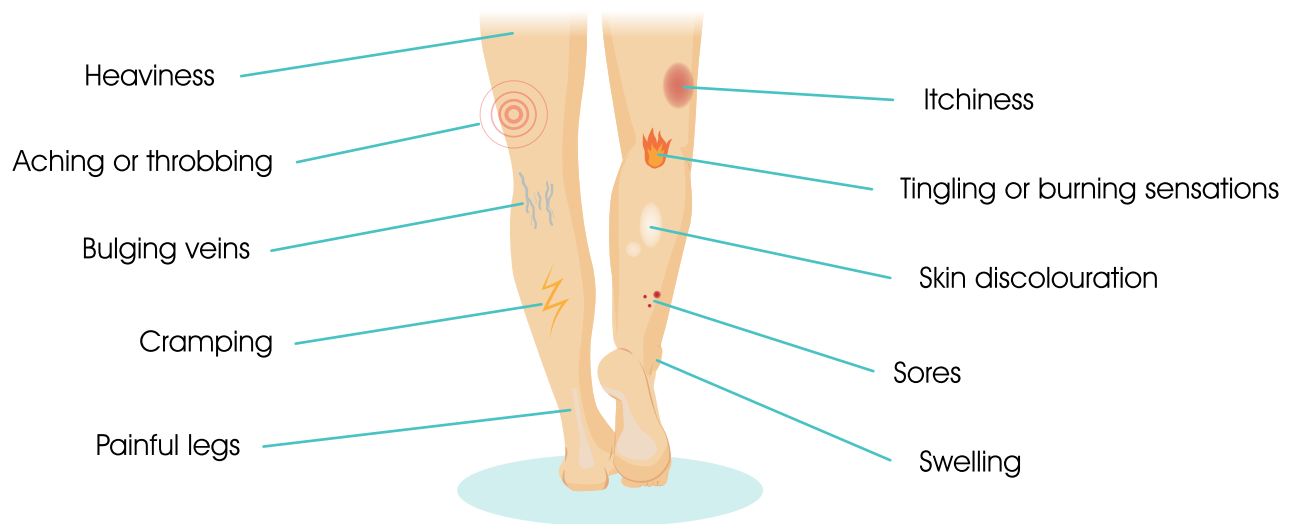

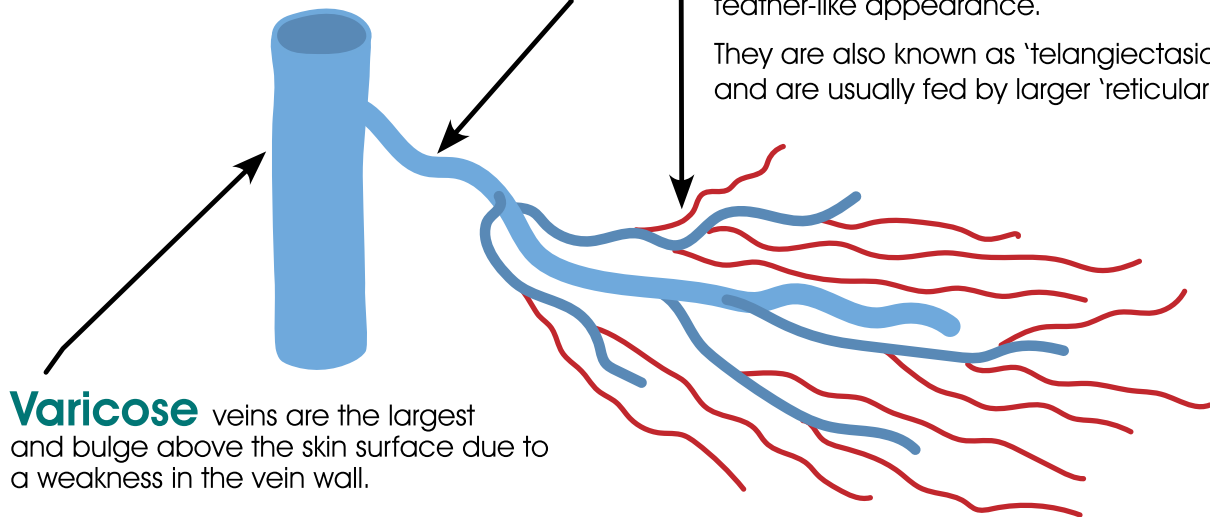

3 COMMON TYPES OF VEINS

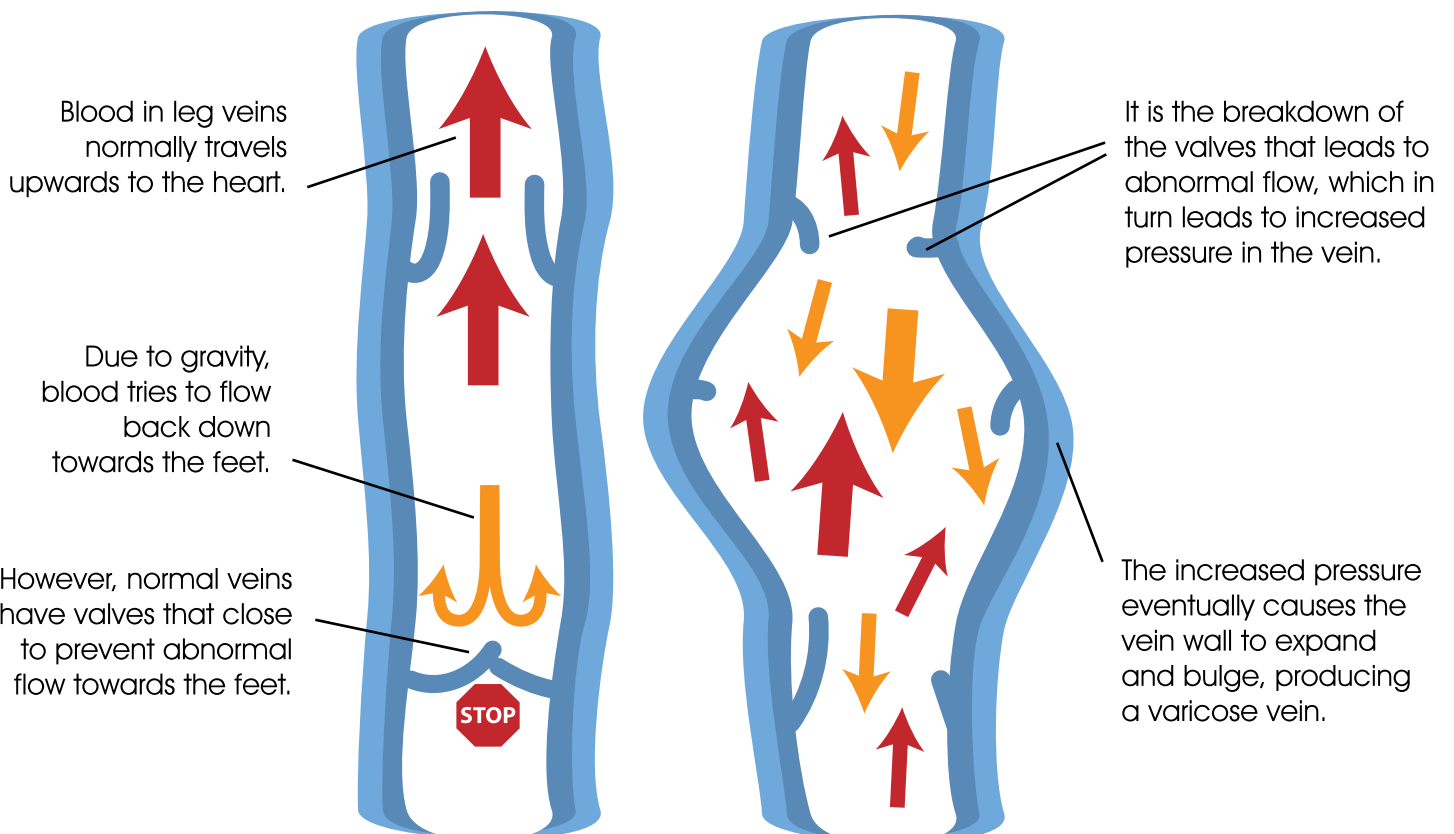

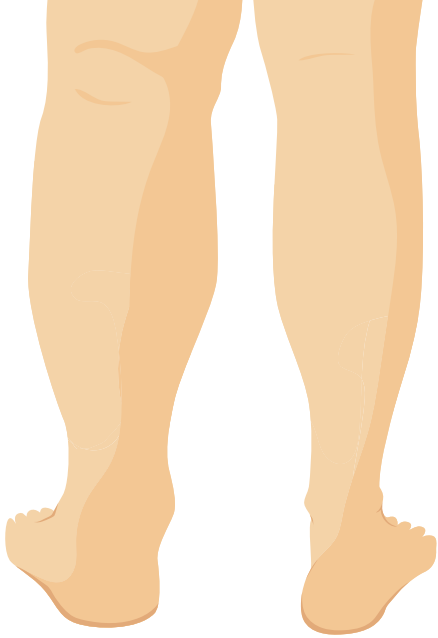
Reticular veins are under the skin and often referred to as 'feeder veins'. They are smaller branches that lead to larger veins. They can appear larger than spider veins and flatter and less twisted than varicose veins.

Spider veins are the finest veins that appear on the surface and can have a feather-like appearance. They are also known as 'telangiectasias' and are usually fed by larger 'reticular veins'.



HOW VEINS BECOME VARICOSE





SWOLLEN LEGS

Venous disease can lead to swollen legs, but swollen legs can be caused by a range of different conditions.

Common causes of swollen legs can include:

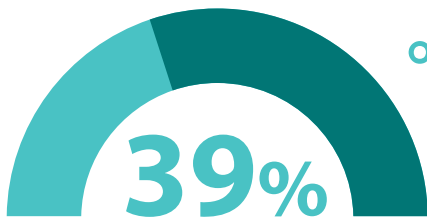
- **obesity**
- **lymphoedema**
- **lipoedema**
- **venous diseases.**

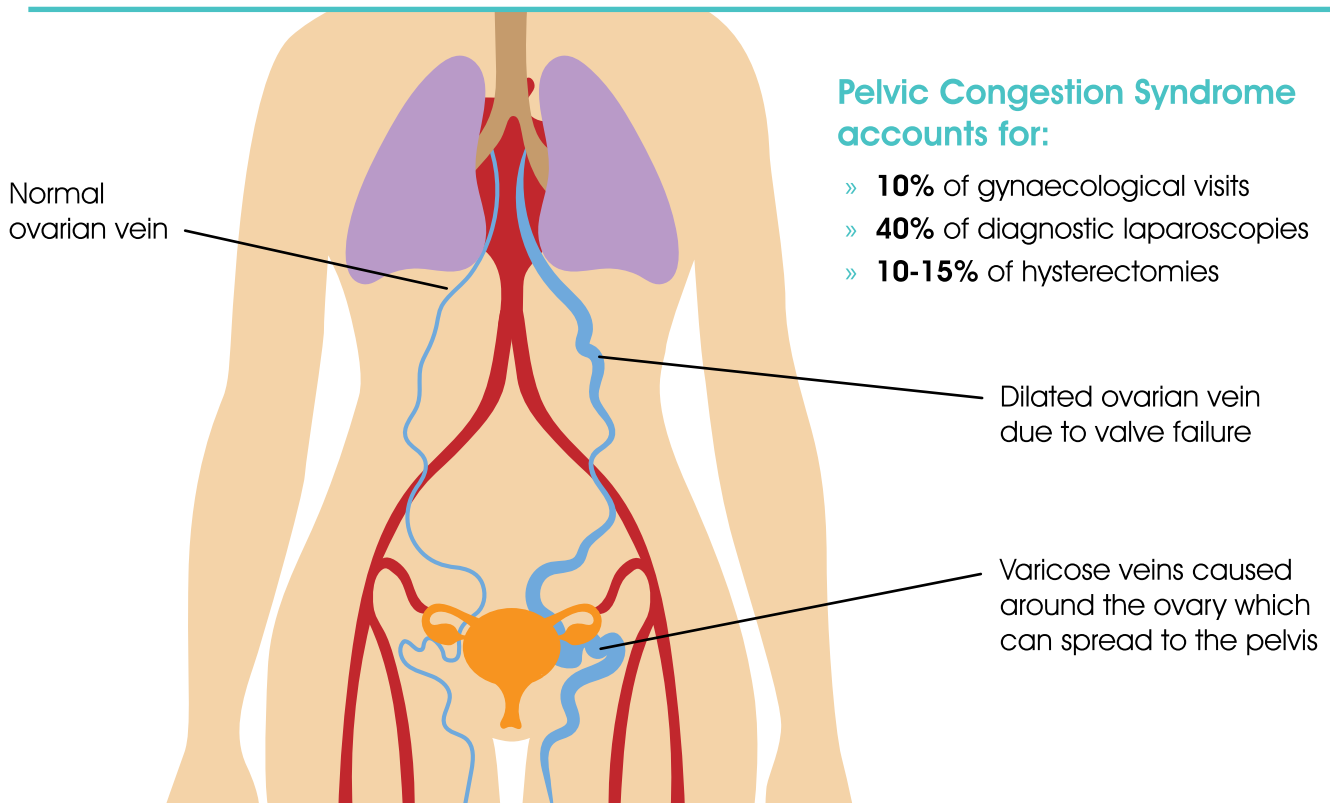
